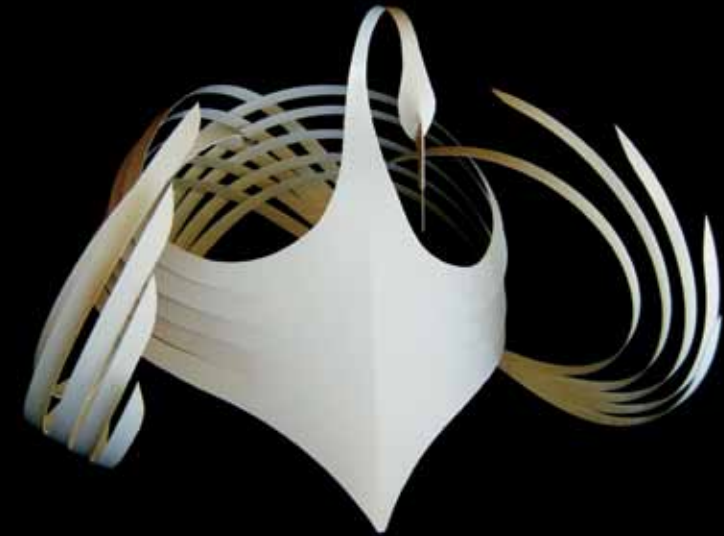

BIJIAN FAN

Bijian Fan was born in Beijing, China. As he grew up, he learned to make paper work toys from his grandmother. Today, he still creates cutting-edge paper sculpture, but his media have expanded to other interesting and beautiful materials. Bijian sculpts three dimensional objects using two dimensional materials, integrating unconventional techniques to create light and airy sculptures. Inspired by nature, his bird sculptures radiate a spatial sense of grace.



Bijian studied in China, Japan, and the USA, earned his B.S. and M.S. in Mathematics and Ph.D. in mechanical engineering. A biotech engineer, he has shown his sculptures across the country and earned numerous awards. He also exhibited at Olympic Cultural Festival in his hometown for Beijing Olympics. Bijian's work is on display at the Artist Union Gallery (#41).

ArtWalk, presented by the City of Ventura Cultural Affairs Division, is a free self-guided walking tour bringing together area artists, studios, galleries, downtown merchants and visitors of all ages in a celebration of Ventura's vibrant professional arts community.
